This newsletter has been created to keep you informed, every month, of the company's developments and the progress of the modernisation work at the Inertam site.

Phoenix rises from its ashes

After almost a year of work and more than €5 million of investment, the factory restarted on 1st July last. Following the temperature increase protocol lasting several days and a series of tests intended to check all equipment, Inertam has resumed production.



A promising start

- ▶ The minor failures that each facility encounters when (re)starting have now all been resolved. Inertam has been operating without an unscheduled shutdown for several weeks.
- ▶ Production rates are increasing: from 10 tonnes per day to 20 tonnes on average with peaks of more than 25 tonnes.
- ▶ On-site waste reception has resumed.
- ▶ The existing stock is gradually being eliminated.
- ▶ The changes made in the load preparation area and in flue gas treatment are satisfactory. Dust in the contained area and atmospheric emissions are considerably reduced, making it possible to envisage an increase in plant availability and therefore production.
- ▶ Logistics have been optimised by redesigning the storage area and installing new infrastructures for the new waste.

Like the phoenix, a mythical, long-lived firebird reborn after being consumed in flames, Inertam has been reborn from its ashes!

The next steps...

- ▶ Making the plant's availability even more reliable.
- ▶ Installing an additional furnace at the end of 2021 to increase the site's production capacity.
- ▶ Optimising the facility's operation.

This "restart" edition of the newsletter is therefore the last... so that its reborn version too will be better! It will be in the form of a quarterly newsletter that will give you a picture of the life and activities of a production site!
